


M4 Smart Motorway

Stage 3 – Mulgoa Road to Mamre Road

Roads and Maritime Services | February 2019



The NSW Government is investing \$470 million to build the M4 Smart Motorway project, which will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 between Pitt Street, Mays Hill and Russell Street, Lapstone.

When complete, the M4 Smart Motorway is expected to:

- reduce average travel times
- provide more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.

Work on **Stage 3** of the M4 Smart Motorway project is expected to be **completed by 2020**, weather permitting.

Work planned for February to April 2019

- Build permanent communications ITS (Intelligent Transport System) infrastructure
- Relocate drainage, water, electricity and communication cables
- Continue drainage work and ramp widening at Mamre Road
- Continue work for overhead gantry footings
- Construct maintenance bays and road surface
- Carry out ongoing geotechnical, survey and utility investigations.



Our work schedule

Our day work hours are between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** and **1pm** **Saturday**, excluding public holidays, weather permitting.

Our night work hours are between **6pm** and **7am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

There will be up to **63 shifts** until **Tuesday 30 April 2019**, excluding public holidays, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including using squawkers rather than beepers on reversing vehicles.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for both road users and construction workers.

Lane closures may be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller directions.

Throughout the course of our work, temporary full or partial ramp closures may be required. We will notify the community in advance of these closures.

Safe removal of asbestos

During our general excavation work, we often find bonded asbestos known as 'asbestos contaminated material' (ACM) within different work areas along the M4 Motorway corridor.

If ACM is found near properties, property owners are notified in advance of any removal and transfer process taking place.

Roads and Maritime Services works with SafeWork NSW and the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) in accordance with the relevant environmental and health obligations, and legislative requirements.

To protect the safety of residents and our workers, our safety procedures require we:

- install safety fencing and exclusion zones
- have licenced specialists present to monitor the work
- cover soil and keep it damp using water sprays to prevent dust
- monitor air quality.
