

M4 Smart Motorway Reservoir Road westbound on ramp

The NSW Government is investing \$470 million to build the **M4 Smart Motorway project.** This project will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 Motorway between Pitt Street, Mays Hill and Russell Street, Lapstone.

The M4 Smart Motorway aims to:

- reduce average travel times
- produce more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.





Kerb and pavement work on ramp

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work on the **Reservoir Road westbound on ramp** at Prospect.

The ramp will be closed for three nights from Tuesday 29 January to Friday 1 February between 9pm and 5am to:

- install new kerbing and lay asphalt
- join the existing roads to the new bridge deck at Reservoir Road.





Our work schedule

Our day work hours are between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm Saturday, excluding public holidays, weather permitting.

Our night work hours are between **6pm** and **7am** from **Sunday** to **Friday.**

Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Detours will be in place during the ramp closure and may affect travel times. Northbound traffic on Reservoir Road will be diverted west along Great Western Highway to enter the M4 Motorway at Wallgrove Road. Southbound traffic on Reservoir Road will be diverted east along the M4 Motorway to join the M4 westbound via the Prospect Highway on ramp.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controller directions.
