



Night work and temporary removal of parking on Burrows Road St Peters

Temporary parking restrictions will be in place along a section of road on the eastern side of Burrows Road around 220 metres north of Canal Road to facilitate demolition work in this area. The parking restrictions will be in place from Wednesday 6 February for approximately six weeks.

What we're doing

The building currently located at no.12 Burrows Road is being demolished as part of the New M5 Project to facilitate bridge construction from the future St Peters interchange, across Alexandra Canal, to Gardeners Road (Mascot). This demolition work will commence on Monday 4 February is expected to take up to six weeks to complete.

For safety reasons, a 50 metre section of parking along the eastern side of Burrows Road, adjacent to the demolition site, is being restricted from 1am on Wednesday 6 February for approximately six weeks.

On Wednesday 6 February between 7pm and 5am, night work will be carried out to install concrete barriers along this section of road.

Please see the map overleaf to better explain the location of the restricted parking spaces.

Traffic changes

A stop/slow traffic set up will be in place along Burrows Road between Canal Road and Campbell Road on Wednesday 6 February from 7pm on 5am to facilitate the installation of concrete barriers. Due to the necessary safety and traffic approvals required for lane closures on Burrows Road, this work must take place at night outside of peak volume times.

As demolition work progresses, the eastern footpath adjacent to the demolition site will be closed intermittently for safety reasons. During footpath closures in this location, traffic control will be in place to direct pedestrians to the opposite footpath.

How this affects you

Equipment used during night work on Wednesday 6 February will include a mobile crane, construction trucks, lighting towers and traffic control.

This work is expected to generate some noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise and light generating equipment away from properties where possible.

Apart from the night work shift on Wednesday 6 February, demolition work is scheduled to take place during standard construction hours: Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm. Local businesses will be notified at least 5 days prior to work taking place outside of these hours if required.
