

Essential maintenance on Warners Bay Road, Mount Hutton from Monday 4 March

The NSW Government is funding this essential maintenance work under its \$1.5 billion maintenance program.

Roads and Maritime Services continually carry out traffic signal maintenance across NSW. Work will start on Warners Bay Road northbound about 60 metres south of Wilson Road, Mount Hutton in March. This work includes upgrading underground cables and in-road sensors and replacing concrete on the footpath on Warners Bay Road.

Our maintenance work aims to improve network reliability and provide consistent driving conditions.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **two night shifts** between **Monday 4 March** and **Friday 29 March**, weather permitting.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Friday**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **11pm**.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.
