

Night work and detour on Gostwyck Bridge, Paterson on Monday 11 March

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance work on Gostwyck Bridge over the Paterson River on Dungog Road to ensure continued safe operation of the bridge.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out the work, which includes resurfacing the bridge deck to improve safety and drainage.

We will be working between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday 11 March** and expect to complete the work in **one night shift**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise and flashing lights.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Lights will be directed away from residences where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Motorists will be unable to travel on Gostwyck Bridge while the work is carried out. A detour will be in place via Horns Crossing Road and Dungog Road at Martins Creek, and Gresford Road at Vacy. We have included a map to show the detour.

The detour is expected to add up to 12 kilometres to journeys and motorists should allow up to 10 minutes extra travel time.


