

# M4 Smart Motorway

## Wallgrove Road ramps at Eastern Creek

The NSW Government is investing \$470 million to build the **M4 Smart Motorway project**. This project will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 Motorway between Pitt Street, Mays Hill and Russell Street, Lapstone.

When complete, the M4 Smart Motorway is expected to:

- reduce average travel times
- provide more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.

### Ramp closures during March

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work at the **Wallgrove Road westbound off ramp, westbound on ramp and eastbound on ramp** at Eastern Creek.

The three Wallgrove Road ramps will be closed for four nights each from **Monday 4 March** to complete Intelligent Transport System (ITS) work (westbound off ramp), and lay asphalt (westbound and eastbound on ramps).



## Our work schedule

We will be on site for 12 nights between **Monday 4 March and Tuesday 26 March**, weather permitting.

Key closure dates and times are listed below.

Day work at this site will continue during this time between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday**.

### Key closure dates

The work at this location has been planned to minimise impact for residents and motorists while completing as much work as possible. The following work is scheduled:

- **Monday 4 to Friday 8 March**  
**Westbound off ramp closure**  
9pm to 5am each night
- **Thursday 14 to Saturday 16 March** then  
**Monday 18 to Wednesday 20 March**  
**Westbound on ramp closure**  
9pm to 5am each night
- **Wednesday 20 to Saturday 23 March** then  
**Monday 25 to Tuesday 26 March**  
**Eastbound on ramp closure**  
9pm to 5am each night

### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- briefing workers to minimise noise
- doing the loudest work before midnight
- using squawkers rather than beepers on reversing vehicles.

### Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Detours will be in place during the ramp closures, and may affect travel times. For the Wallgrove Road **westbound off ramp** closure, motorists can exit the M4 Motorway at Reservoir Road off ramp or Roper Road off ramp.

For the Wallgrove Road **westbound on ramp** closure, motorists will be diverted to the Great Western Highway to enter the M4 Motorway at Roper Road on ramp.

For the Wallgrove Road **eastbound on ramp** closure, motorists will be diverted south along Wallgrove Road to enter the M4 Motorway at Roper Road on ramp.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controller directions.
