## Reservoir Road westbound off ramp

The NSW Government is building the **M4 Smart Motorway project**. This project will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 Motorway between Pitt Street, Mays Hill and Mulgoa Road, Penrith.

When complete, the M4 Smart Motorway is expected to:

- reduce average travel times
- provide more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.

### Landscaping work near ramp

Roads and Maritime Services is completing work at the **Reservoir Road westbound off ramp** at Prospect.

The Reservoir Road ramp will be closed for three nights **between 9pm and 5am** from **Wednesday 19 June** to **Saturday 22 June** to complete landscaping in this area.

We will be on site for three nights between **Wednesday 19 June** and **Saturday 22 June**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between 9pm and 5am.

Day work at this site will continue during this time between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturday**.

## How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- briefing workers to minimise noise
- doing the loudest work before midnight
- using squawkers rather than beepers on reversing vehicles.

## Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Detours will be in place during the closures and may affect travel times.

Motorists can exit the M4 Motorway at the Prospect Highway.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controller directions.
