


M4 Smart Motorway

Wallgrove Road ramps at Eastern Creek

The NSW Government is building the **M4 Smart Motorway project**. This project will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 Motorway.

When complete, the M4 Smart Motorway is expected to:

- reduce average travel times
- provide more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.

Safety barrier installations

Roads and Maritime is starting work to upgrade the M7 to M4 eastbound and westbound on ramps at Eastern Creek.

As part of this work, the **Wallgrove Road eastbound** and **westbound on ramps** at Eastern Creek will be closed for a total of five nights from **9pm to 5am** from **Sunday 16 June** to **Friday 21 June** to install safety barriers.



Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to five nights between **Sunday 16 June** and **Friday 21 June** between **9pm** and **5am**, weather permitting.

Key closure dates and times are listed below.

Day work at these sites will continue during this time between **7am** and **6pm** **Monday to Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** **Saturday**.

Key closure dates

The work at this location has been planned to minimise impact for residents and motorists while completing as much work as possible:

- **Sunday 16 to Tuesday 18 June**
Two night closure
9pm to 5am each night (eastbound on ramp)
- **Tuesday 18 to Friday 21 June**
Three night closure
9pm to 5am each night (westbound on ramp).

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- briefing workers to minimise noise
- doing the loudest work before midnight
- using squawkers rather than beepers on reversing vehicles.

Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Detours will be in place during the ramp closures, and may affect travel times.

For the Wallgrove Road **eastbound on ramp** closure, motorists will be diverted to join the Great Western Highway and head east. Motorists can then join the M4 at Reservoir Road.

For the Wallgrove Road **westbound on ramp** closure, motorists will be diverted to the Great Western Highway to enter the M4 Motorway at either Reservoir Road (to the east) or Mamre Road (to the west).

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controller directions.
